GOD'S WILL REVEALED

QUESTION 1

Matthew 4:4 (NKJV) But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.' "

QUESTION 2

2 Peter 1:21 (NKJV) for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

2 Peter 1:20 (NKJV) knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation,

(Rom 16:26 KJV) But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith:

QUESTION 3

2 Timothy 3:16 (NKJV) All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,

2 Timothy 3:17 (NKJV) that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

(2 Tim 3:16 NASB) All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;

(2 Tim 3:17 NASB) that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

QUESTION 4

James 2:19 (NKJV) You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe; and tremble!

James 2:20 (NKJV) But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead?

James 2:24 (NKJV) You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only.

James 1:22 (NKJV) But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

Matthew 7:21 (NKJV) "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.

QUESTION 5

Matthew 7:13 (NKJV) "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it.

Matthew 7:14 (NKJV) "Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

QUESTION 6

Colossians 2:8 (NKJV) Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ.

Matthew 15:9 (NKJV) And in vain they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.'

QUESTION 7

Galatians 1:6 (NKJV) I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel,

Galatians 1:7 (NKJV) which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ.

Galatians 1:8 (NKJV) But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed.

Galatians 1:9 (NKJV) As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.

QUESTION 8

2 John 1:9 (NKJV) Whoever transgresses {*goeth onward, ASV; goes too far, NASB*} and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.

2 John 1:10 (NKJV) If anyone comes to you and does not bring this doctrine, do not receive him into your house nor greet him;

2 John 1:11 (NKJV) for he who greets him shares in his evil deeds.

QUESTION 9

2 Timothy 2:15 (NKJV) Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing {*handling accurately, NASB*} the word of truth.

QUESTION 10

Exodus 34:27 (NKJV) Then the LORD said to Moses, "Write these words, for according to the tenor of these words I have made a covenant with you and with Israel."

Exodus 34:28 (NKJV) So he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he neither ate bread nor drank water. And He wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.

Jeremiah 31:31 (NKJV) "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah;

Jeremiah 31:32 (NKJV) "not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD.

QUESTION 11

Colossians 2:14 (NKJV) having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

(Eph 2:14 NKJV) For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation,

Ephesians 2:15 (NKJV) having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace,

Ephesians 2:16 (NKJV) and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.

QUESTION 12

Hebrews 10:9 (NKJV) then He said, "Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God." He takes away the first that He may establish the second.

(Heb 8:7 NKJV) For if that first covenant had been faultless, then no place would have been sought for a second.

(Heb 8:8 NKJV) Because finding fault with them, He says: "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah;

(Heb 8:9 NKJV) "not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they did not continue in My covenant, and I disregarded them, says the LORD. [Compare with Jeremiah 31:31-32]

Hebrews 9:16 (NKJV) For where there is a testament, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator.

Hebrews 9:17 (NKJV) For a testament is in force after men are dead, since it has no power at all while the testator lives.

QUESTION 13

Romans 7:4 (NKJV) Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another; to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God.

Hebrews 10:9 (NKJV) then He said, "Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God." He takes away the first that He may establish the second.

Romans 7:6 (NKJV) But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter.

Romans 7:7 (NKJV) What shall we say then? Is the law sin? Certainly not! On the contrary, I would not have known sin except through the law. For I would not have known covetousness unless the law had said, "You shall not covet."

QUESTION 14

Galatians 3:23 (NKJV) But before faith came, we were kept under guard by the law, kept for the faith which would afterward be revealed.

Galatians 3:24 (NKJV) Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

Galatians 3:25 (NKJV) But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.

Galatians 3:26 (NKJV) For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

Galatians 3:27 (NKJV) For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Galatians 3:28 (NKJV) There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

QUESTION 15

John 12:48 (NKJV) "He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him; the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day."

Hebrews 1:1 (NKJV) God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets,

Hebrews 1:2 (NKJV) has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;

QUESTION 16

Matthew 28:18 (NKJV) And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

QUESTION 17

Matthew 5:21 (NKJV) "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder, and whoever murders will be in danger of the judgment.'

Matthew 5:22 (NKJV) "But I say to you that whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment. And whoever says to his brother, 'Raca!' shall be in danger of the council. But whoever says, 'You fool!' shall be in danger of hell fire.

Matthew 5:27 (NKJV) "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not commit adultery.'

Matthew 5:28 (NKJV) "But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

Matthew 5:31 (NKJV) "Furthermore it has been said, 'Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.'

Matthew 5:32 (NKJV) "But I say to you that whoever divorces his wife for any reason except sexual immorality causes her to commit adultery; and whoever marries a woman who is divorced commits adultery.

Matthew 7:28 (NKJV) And so it was, when Jesus had ended these sayings, that the people were astonished at His teaching,

Matthew 7:29 (NKJV) for He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.

QUESTION 18

1 Corinthians 14:37 (NKJV) If anyone thinks himself to be a prophet or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things which I write to you are the commandments of the Lord.

2 Peter 3:1 (NKJV) Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in both of which I stir up your pure minds by way of reminder),

2 Peter 3:2 (NKJV) that you may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us, the apostles of the Lord and Savior,

(2 Pe 3:15 KJV) And account *that* the longsuffering of our Lord *is* salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;

(2 Pet 3:16 KJV) As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as *they do* also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.
