

# **BIBLE STUDY LESSON 2**

## **OBEYING GOD'S WILL**

### **QUESTION 1**

Titus 2:12 (NKJV) teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,

### **QUESTION 2**

Isaiah 59:2 (NKJV) But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear.

### **QUESTION 3**

(1 John 3:4 KJV) Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

2 John 1:9 (NKJV) Whoever transgresses {*goeth onward, ASV; goes too far, NASB*} and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.

James 4:17 (NKJV) Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin.

Romans 1:28 (NKJV) And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting;

Romans 1:29 (NKJV) being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; they are whisperers,

Romans 1:30 (NKJV) backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,

Romans 1:31 (NKJV) undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful;

Romans 1:32 (NKJV) who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them.

Colossians 3:8 (NKJV) But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth.

### **QUESTION 4**

1 John 1:8 (NKJV) If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

## QUESTION 5

John 5:28 (NKJV) "Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice

John 5:29 (NKJV) "and come forth; those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation.

2 Corinthians 5:10 (NKJV) For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

2 Corinthians 5:11 (NKJV) Knowing, therefore, the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are well known to God, and I also trust are well known in your consciences.

Matthew 1:21 (NKJV) "And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins."

1 John 4:14 (NKJV) And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son as Savior of the world.

Ephesians 1:7 (NKJV) In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

Hebrews 9:12 (NKJV) Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

Romans 5:8 (NKJV) But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:9 (NKJV) Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

### QUESTION 8

Acts 4:12 (NKJV) "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV) But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Romans 10:17 (NKJV) So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

John 20:30 (NKJV) And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book;

John 20:31 (NKJV) but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

1 Timothy 3:16 (NKJV) And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifested in the flesh, Justified in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Preached among the Gentiles, Believed on in the world, Received up in glory.

### QUESTION 13

Hebrews 5:8 (NKJV) though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered.  
Hebrews 5:9 (NKJV) And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,

2 Thessalonians 1:7 (NKJV) and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels,

2 Thessalonians 1:8 (NKJV) in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Thessalonians 1:9 (NKJV) These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power,

1 John 2:3 (NKJV) Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments.

1 John 2:4 (NKJV) He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
