

# BIBLE STUDY LESSON 3

## BAPTISM

### QUESTION 1

Matthew 28:18 (NKJV) And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

Matthew 28:19 (NKJV) "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

Matthew 28:20 (NKJV) "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Mark 16:15 (NKJV) And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

Mark 16:16 (NKJV) "He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

### QUESTION 2

Acts 2:38 (NKJV) Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 10:48 (NKJV) And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then they asked him to stay a few days.

Acts 2:38 (NKJV) Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

(1 Pet 3:21 KJV) The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

### QUESTION 5

Ephesians 4:4 (NKJV) There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling;

Ephesians 4:5 (NKJV) one Lord, one faith, one baptism;

Ephesians 4:6 (NKJV) one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

### QUESTION 6

Acts 8:36 (NKJV) Now as they went down the road, they came to some water. And the eunuch said, "See, here is water. What hinders me from being baptized?"

Acts 8:37 (NKJV) Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."

Acts 8:38 (NKJV) So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him.

### QUESTION 7

(Rom 6:3 KJV) Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?

(Rom 6:4 KJV) Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

(Rom 6:5 KJV) For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:

Colossians 2:12 (NKJV) buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

### QUESTION 9

Acts 18:8 (NKJV) Then Crispus, the ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his household. And many of the Corinthians, hearing, believed and were baptized.

Acts 8:12 (NKJV) But when they believed Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were baptized.

Acts 8:13 (NKJV) Then Simon himself also believed; and when he was baptized he continued with Philip, and was amazed, seeing the miracles and signs which were done.

Acts 2:41 (NKJV) Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.

Mark 16:15 (NKJV) And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

Mark 16:16 (NKJV) "He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

Acts 19:5 (NKJV) When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

## THE BODY OF CHRIST: THE CHURCH

### QUESTION 13

Ephesians 1:22-23 (NKJV) And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

Colossians 1:18 (NKJV) And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.

### QUESTION 14

Ephesians 4:4 (NKJV) There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling;

1 Corinthians 12:20 (NKJV) But now indeed there are many members, yet one body.

### QUESTION 15

Romans 12:4 (NKJV) For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function,

Romans 12:5 (NKJV) so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.

1 Corinthians 12:12 (NKJV) For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ.

1 Corinthians 12:27 (NKJV) Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually.

### QUESTION 16

Ephesians 5:23 (NKJV) For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body.

### QUESTION 17

John 17:20-21 (NKJV) "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.

## QUESTION 18

1 Corinthians 1:10 (NKJV) Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

1 Corinthians 1:11 (NKJV) For it has been declared to me concerning you, my brethren, by those of Chloe's household, that there are contentions among you.

1 Corinthians 1:12 (NKJV) Now I say this, that each of you says, "I am of Paul," or "I am of Apollos," or "I am of Cephas," or "I am of Christ."

1 Corinthians 1:13 (NKJV) Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?

## QUESTION 19

Acts 11:26 (NKJV) And when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. So it was that for a whole year they assembled with the church and taught a great many people. And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.

Acts 26:28 (NKJV) Then Agrippa said to Paul, "You almost persuade me to become a Christian."

Romans 16:16 (NKJV) Greet one another with a holy kiss. The churches of Christ greet you.
